

**Description:** Salt Creek (Quebrada Sal) is a remote Ngäbe-Buglé indigenous village located on the southeastern end of Bastimentos Island in Panama's Bocas del Toro Province. Home to approximately 900 residents, the community maintains a traditional lifestyle centered around fishing, subsistence farming, and handcrafted goods. Houses are typically built on stilts with thatched palm roofs, reflecting the region's cultural heritage. Accessible by boat through mangrove-lined channels, Salt Creek offers visitors an authentic cultural experience. The village has embraced community-led ecotourism, providing guided nature walks, cultural demonstrations, and opportunities to purchase local crafts. Its proximity to Bastimentos National Marine Park and the Zapatilla Cays makes it an ideal destination for those seeking to explore Panama's rich biodiversity and indigenous cultures.
